

## **Primary Consultation**

Our Consultation for our proposal to convert to a Primary School in September 2017 is due to close at **Noon on the 11th December 2015.** There is still time to respond. Responses can be made through submitting the response form at the back of the Consultation Document, or through the link on our school website.

All responses will be reviewed thoroughly and a full analysis will be completed and made available on our school website. If you have requested a copy of the analysis to be emailed to you, it will be sent as soon as it has been agreed by the Governing Body on 7th January 2016.

Although we will have clear picture of stakeholder feeling and a decision made by the Governing Body, we will not know if the Local Authority Executive have voted to change to Two Tier until after January 20th-when the Executive have formally met.

Children in Foundation Stage, Year 1 and Year 2 have their meals provided free of charge through the Government 'Universal Infant Free School Meals' Scheme.

Children who fulfil the criteria for Free School Meals are eligible for 'Pupil Premium Funding' This is additional funding which is used to support your child's learning and can remove any financial barriers that prevent children having opportunities.

## Holiday Absence

We are still receiving requests for holiday absence, despite the Government guidelines which are in place. Please be advised that all holiday absence requests will be denied unless there are truly exceptional circumstances.

Whole School Attendance is at 98% so far, which is outstanding. We would very much like this to continue into the school year.

Unfortunately, we have had to issue our first Fixed Penalty Notice Referral which has resulted in a fine. This is not something we have done lightly and hope we will not have to do often. The guidelines on school absence are tighter than ever and absence will only be granted in exceptional circumstances or when accompanied by a letter from an employer. Please be advised letters from employers may be followed up by a phone call to clarify the situation of gain further information.



#### School Uniform

Please can we remind Parents / Carers about our School Uniform Policy.

We appreciate Parents/Carers following the school policies and ensuring that your children are well prepared and smart for school. We would like to remind parents about the following: **Boots** - are acceptable in Winter for inside school, they need to be plain and black **Hair Bands** - should be simple, small and black or red in colour. Please do not allow your child to wear flowers in their hair, wear large bright / sparkly hairbands or have their hair down.

**Tights / Socks** - Tights need to be plain, either red, black or grey. Socks should be white or black/ grey

**Watches** - Children are permitted to wear watches—although they must be small, plain and simple. If a child is unable to wear a watch without constant fiddling, they will be asked to take it off and put it in their book bag to go home.

**Pencil Cases** -Year 3 and 4. Children don't really need pencil cases as all stationary is provided for them, however if you wish to send a pencil case, please ensure it is named. They will need to be stored in children's trays as our tables are not big enough for extra equipment.

The exceptions to these rules are: Mufti-Days when hair bands etc. can be the child's choice. Wednesday 16th December—Christmas Jumper Day, when children can wear Christmas hair bands etc. and the last day of term , 18th December, when children can wear Christmas Hats, antlers, sparkly bands etc.—should they choose to. (Although the 18th is still a Uniform Day NOT Mufti)
