Staff News

We have successfully appointed two new teachers for September, one for Foundation Stage to work alongside Mrs Lee, and one for Year 4 to work alongside Mrs Hall. We are very pleased to say that Miss Eve, who has spent most of this last year working with Mrs Lee and Miss Dennison in Snails class has been appointed as our new Foundation Teacher.

Miss Eve have been highly committed to our children throughout her time at Ursula Taylor and has demonstrated a high level of teaching skill. We are very happy to have been able to appoint such a good teacher, who will be a valuable asset to our school.

For Year 4, we have appointed Miss Mayston, who is just finishing her Teacher Training. Miss Mayston will be mentored by Mrs Hall, our Deputy Headteacher who will be moving into Year 4.

We are just finalising the classes and teacher placements for September, and you will be informed in due course which class your child will be in and who your child's Class Teacher and Teaching Assistants will be.
