Events coming up at UTS!

We have a few things coming up fairly soon – please take a note of these dates and we'll see you there!

Thursday October 13th - Foundation Stage Phonics information evening. If you have a child in Foundation Stage you will be invited to attend a sessions led by Mrs Lee and Miss Eve explaining about the way we teach your children phonics. This is a great session which we hope will give parents ideas to use at home when supporting their children's learning. More information will come home shortly in the Foundation Stage book bags.

Wednesday October 19th - Harvest festival

We are holding our annual harvest celebration at 9:30am on the 19th October in our hall. Each class will be presenting something and Stephen is coming along to help us celebrate. We always like to invite parents to attend this event and we know that it is always popular. However, in order to give as many children as possible the chance to have a family member attend, we are limiting the spaces to 1 per family. We know it is disappointing that more people can't attend, however, we have Christmas fast approaching and there will be more than 1 ticket for each family.

We have decided to support the Bedford Food Bank again this year, it is a cause close to home and has been a great support to some of our families. Last year we were able to donate enough produce for 343 meals! It would be wonderful to exceed this total if we could.

Please try to send something in on the day of the Harvest festival – tins, packets, bottles (not alcohol) fruit, veg, dried goods – all are welcome. Just please make sure they are in date.

Reminder 31st October 2016 is a Training Day at school – staff will be in, but children are not. Thank you.

November 1st, **2**nd **and 3**rd are parent Consultation Days - the sign-up sheets will be going up on Monday 10th October in the school foyer. We do encourage children to attend the consultations as they are meetings to talk about successes and next steps. If you or your child's teacher needs to discuss anything confidential, then we always ask your child to wait outside just for a few minutes.
