# Sports' Day 2014

We are holding our annual Sport's Day on Tuesday July 1st at 1:30pm. The format will be similar to last year. ### Transfer Events

We are fast approaching the time when we have a series of sessions for the children to prepare themselves for moving into a new class. We will be letting you know which teacher your child will have at the start of w/b 7th July.

### w/b 7th July is our Transfer week.

Year 4 are at Lincroft for 3 days (Tuesday 8th, Wednesday 9th and Thursday 10th)

On Wednesday and Thursday our children will spend the day in their new class with their new Teacher and Teaching Assistant. These days will involve the children learning about new routines and give time for staff to get to know their new children.

### DANGEROUS DRIVING IN OUR PLAYGROUND

I have received a worrying report about a parent driving dangerously in our playground after collection from Active Kids. Apparently the parent was seen wheel spinning and revving the car repeatedly.

I would like to make it clear that this is not behaviour we expect of our parents and that it is wholly inappropriate. I have been given a description of the car and staff are aware to be on the look out in case of a reoccurrence.

The playground is opened as a convenience for parents needing to drop off and collect from Active Kids. Any repeat of this nature will result in the gates being locked and no access to the playground being allowed.

This may seem a harsh message but the safety of our parents and children is paramount.

I would like to thank those parents that drive and park responsibly and I hope we will not have to resort to closing the playground to parking.



### **REMINDER!**



Please can parents ensure that children are not wearing jewellery to school. (Only stud earrings are permitted) There has been an increase in bracelets and 'loom' bands and these are not part of our school uniform. There is a Health and Safety risk attached to jewellery which we need to manage carefully.

Please can you also make sure if your child wears earrings (studs) that they can be removed by your child for PE and swimming. Children are NOT permitted to have tape over their earrings in the pool as they come off and damage the filter. We cannot allow children to swim unless they can take out their earrings or have come to school without them in. Swimming donation money is £14 per family or £2 weekly.
