*In Science we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will be focussing on how we can classify different animals and recognise changes that happen within the environment.*

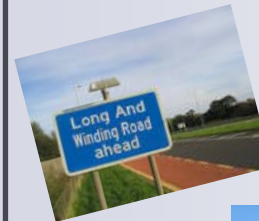
## Home Learning Tasks

PE: PE lessons are on a Tuesday and a Thursday. Please ensure your child has appropriate footwear and a dark coloured tracksuit for outdoor lessons.

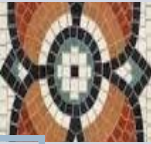
Reading: Please could you continue to listen to your child read regularly at home (at least 3 times per week). Thank you.
