Sports Premium 2018 / 2019

Spending Report

The Sports Premium is allocated to schools to make additional and sustained improvements to the provision of PE and sport for the benefit of all pupils to encourage the development of healthy active lifestyles.

Sports premium allocated funding is calculated using the following, based on numbers of pupils in Year 1 – Year 6.

- Schools with 17 or more pupils receive £16000 plus £10 per pupil
- o Schools with 16 or fewer pupils receive £1000 per pupil.

For the school year 2018/2019 Ursula Taylor received £18,780. A carry forward from previous grants of £15,873 gave a total £34,653. Total expenditure for 2018/2019 was £20,322.

A balance of £14,331 will carry forward into 2019/2010 to ensure the continuous provision of SSG services, SSCO and identified areas for developing PE within the school.

Sustainability and long term vision for the use of the Sport's Funding at Ursula Taylor C of E Primary School

At Ursula Taylor we have use the Sports Funding to target specific groups of children and also support all children to access quality PE lessons and Extra-Curricular experiences. This includes purchasing new resources, working alongside specialist coaches to support learning and also increase the subject knowledge and confidence of our non-specialist staff. Any underspend from the 2018/2019 Funding will be used to further resources areas as they are required, inclusive of the PE curriculum offer and additional after school clubs.

Future spending of Sports Funding will be linked to developing the subject knowledge and the skills of our Teachers and Teaching assistants through the use of external specialist coaches who will work directly with the children and alongside staff.

In addition to this we will be developing a broad, balanced and access for all led Extra-Curriculum package. This will be a combination of:

- Free clubs at lunchtime and afterschool run by SSG (Paid for by the school through Sports Funding)
- Free clubs at lunchtime and afterschool run by Teachers and Teaching Assistants (Costs covered by the Sports Funding where relevant)
- 4 After school competitions / matches run by the Teachers and the Sharnbrook School SSCO group (Paid for by the school through Sports Funding)
- → During school festivals, (in addition to the PE Curriculum) inter-school sports competitions, intra-school sports competitions. Run by the Teachers and Teaching Assistants. (paid for by the school through the Sports Funding)
