

Every child has their attendance monitored by the school and externally by the Local Authority Educational Welfare Officer. Children who fall below $85 \%$ are considered to be 'Persistent Absentees'. This involves a much closer scrutiny and actions by the Office Manager / Headteacher. It is necessary on occasion, when attendance falls below $85 \%$ to place children and their parents on 'Attendance Review'. This involves formal meetings with the Headteacher and the Educational Welfare Officer who set tight targets for parents to achieve in order to improve their child's attendance and ultimately improve their chances of achieving their potential.
