Good Attendance Means ...

Being in school at least 95% of the time or 180 to 190 days



Every child has their attendance monitored by the school and externally by the Local Authority Educational Welfare Officer. Children who fall below 85% are considered to be 'Persistent Absentees'. This involves a much closer scrutiny and actions by the Office Manager / Headteacher. It is necessary on occasion, when attendance falls below 85% to place children and their parents on 'Attendance Review'. This involves formal meetings with the Headteacher and the Educational Welfare Officer who set tight targets for parents to achieve in order to improve their child's attendance and ultimately improve their chances of achieving their potential.
