'Active Kids' wraparound Care

We have a breakfast and after school club which means children can be at school from 7:30 – 6pm each day.

This is run by staff who work on school during the day, this means they know the pastoral needs of our children incredibly well.

We also run an Easter and Summer Holiday club for some of the break to support parents who need to work and to give children a fun, social experience.





Our Phoenix Club and Well-Being support At Ursula Taylor we believe that children learn best when they are happy, settled and coping with the challenges that life throws at us. In addition to the support we offer in class, we have a dedicated club for children to attend if they need a little extra to build resilience, learn to understand their emotions or just need a boost in confidence. Phoenix club is a mix of nurture sessions and 'Build it' club when children learn to create things through woodwork to support their emotional development.
