Autumn Term in Year 1 we will be learning.....

English


All children in Year 1 undertake daily sessions in accordance with the 'Supersonic Phonic Friends' systematic phonics programme, building upon their previous experiences in Reception.

In our English work this term we will explore the text 'Last Stop on Market Street' and link to the whole school Write Stuff scheme of work.

Religious Education

We will learn about:

- The different places that people go to worship;
- Special objects and symbols and what they mean to believers;
- and
- The traditions and meanings associated with Harvest.
- Learning about Parables 'The Parable of the Lost Son'.



Maths

Our maths work in Year 1 is:

- **Practical:** We learn to use a range of tools to help us; and
- Prioritises the use of **mathematical language:** We practice speaking in full sentences to explain our thinking and develop our understanding of tricky concepts and ideas.

We will be:

- Sorting, grouping and representing numbers and quantities to 10 in a range of ways (including numerals);
- Developing strategies for counting reliably;
- Exploring ideas of 'one more', 'one less' and 'equal';
- Comparing quantities using 'greater than' (>) and 'less than' (<);
- Ordering and sequencing numbers and quantities.

Science

We will:

- Draw and label parts of the body;
- Learn about each of our 5 Senses and know which parts of the body they relate to;
- Undertake simple investigations;
- Explore the theme of Autumn and observe seasonal change.



Our Topic

Our Topic this term is
'Marvellous Me!'



We will:

- Learn all about our local area and important places, features and people within our community;
- Explore different types of houses and homes;
- Describe and follow a simple route and learn some simple map skills;
- Plan, make and evaluate 'Our Fabric Faces', learning to use a range of materials and joining techniques.

Computing

We will learn some basic computing skills, with an emphasis on using technology safely and respectfully. For example:

- Moving a cursor/using a mouse;
- Launching an application;
- Drop and drag objects.

Reading

All children will be given school reading books and phonics packs linked to their learning in Phonics. Children will soon have the opportunity to borrow school library books of their choice.
